Opioid-related overdoses took the lives of 33,000 Americans in 2015, according to the CDC. That's just slightly less than the 38,300 Americans who died in traffic fatalities that same year! Just this April, the agency said its findings suggest the opioid epidemic might be much worse than previously thought. Thousands of opioid-related fatalities go uncounted because the drugs often are not listed on autopsy reports as contributing causes of death.
