He is a fellow of the Society of Actuaries and a member of the American Academy of Actuaries. Mr. Parciak graduated from the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, Massachusetts with an A.B. degree in mathematics. He also studied math at Florida State University Graduate School, prior to induction into the U.S. Army.
