

# Health Care Reform— What Will It Mean for Employers?

Coming into office, health care was President Obama's number one domestic issue. And, despite the inevitable political ups and downs, the administration's focus has remained persistent. We see things continuing to evolve rapidly in Washington, and we can't predict with certainty what will happen with the various health reform efforts of early 2010. However, even without comprehensive health reform, we see inevitable changes in the U.S. health care system. This session will review the latest health care proposals being debated in Congress and the latest political movements, provide likely outcomes from health reform efforts, examine general trends in the U.S. health system, and provide examples of what employers can expect, including changes to the insurance market, changes to Medicare and Medicaid, employer mandates, individual mandates, increased taxes, and real cost-reduction opportunities.
