

ISCEBS Strategic Planning Committee

Function Description



Preamble

The Committee shall serve the best interests of the International Society of Certified Employee Benefit Specialists (ISCEBS) and its members. Its basic charge is to make recommendations to the Governing Council regarding the Society's strategic plans. Minutes from each Committee meeting shall be submitted to the Governing Council.

1. Composition/Appointment

The Committee shall consist of six members, the current year Society president and the five most recent past presidents. The immediate Society past president shall be appointed chair.

2. Scope of Duties

- A. The Committee shall review and make recommendations regarding the Society's strategic plans, including its goals and objectives.
- B. Committee members shall actively promote Society membership and chapter membership to those holding the CEBS, CMS, GBA or RPA designation and to CEBS students who have completed at least one CEBS course.
- C. Committee members shall support and actively promote the CEBS continuing professional education (CPE) requirement.
- D. Committee members shall carry out other projects and directives that may be assigned by the Governing Council or the Board of Directors.

3. Responsibility of Committee Members

- A. Members shall be aware of the relevant budget allocations and keep them in mind when formulating recommendations.
- B. Members shall become familiar with the minutes of the previous meeting.
- C. Members shall make every effort to attend the Committee meeting and review information sent to them on a periodic basis.
