2019 COURSE

Insurance CE Credit

ISCEBS recommends 30 credit hours per course/track in British Columbia, Manitoba, Nova Scotia, Ontario and Saskatchewan.

The 2019 courses will be submitted to the Alberta Insurance Council for preapproval. In 2018, the Alberta Insurance Council approved the ISCEBS CE Fellowship Courses: Group Benefits was approved for 11 life, accident and sickness credits, and Group Retirement was approved for 11 life credits. Insurance agents from Alberta and Manitoba will receive a certificate of completion.

All other provinces accept the pass notice from Prometric as proof of credit earned. Contact ISCEBS for reporting procedures.

Registered Insurance Brokers of Ontario (RIBO)

The 2019 continuing education courses will be submitted to the Registered Insurance Brokers of Ontario (RIBO) for accreditation upon request. The 2018 ISCEBS CE Fellowship Course—Group Benefits was approved for 16 hours Management. The 2018 ISCEBS CE Fellowship Course—Group Retirement was approved for 16 hours Management. A certificate will be mailed upon completion if requested on the registration form.

On-Site Testing Option—Canada
