Many members use the Society's Fellow courses to meet licensing and other professional continuing education requirements. The following information is provided to give you a basic understanding of the continuing education credit available to Society members. 2020 Course

STATE LICENSING AND PROFESSIONAL CREDIT INFORMATION INSURANCE PRODUCERS

Insurance CE Credit

ISCEBS will seek approval of the Fellow courses only in states where this service is requested on exam application forms.

The state approvals will be posted at www.iscebs.org as they are received. If there is no indication that the course is pending approval in your state, you MUST contact us and request credit at least **45 days** prior to taking the exam. If your state is not approved, the last day to request CE will be June 1, 2020. **Do not sit for your exam until your state has been approved**.

A list of hours approved for last year's courses is available at www.iscebs.org and can be used as an *approximation* of the number of hours that could be granted for the 2020 course.

Certified Financial Planner (CFP®)

The 2020 courses will be submitted to the CFP Board of Standards for approval. In 2019, the health track was approved for six (6) credit hours, the retirement track for six (6) credit hours and the combined exam for twelve (12) credit hours.

Attorneys

State regulations vary as to whether self-study courses are accepted for credit. Attorneys in most states can seek approval of the continuing education course from the State Bar/Commission on Continuing Legal Education. The \$25 service charge does not apply.

IRS Continuing Education

The International Society of Certified Employee Benefit Specialists is an IRS-approved continuing education provider. The 2020 ISCEBS Fellow courses have been submitted to the IRS for approval. The 2019 Health Care track was approved for 8.0 credit hours in the Qualified Retirement Plan Matters category. The 2019 Retirement track was approved for 8.0 credit hours in the Qualified Retirement Plan Matters category. Approval information for 2020 will be posted at www.iscebs.org. Approved audience: Enrolled Agents (EA)/Enrolled Retirement Plan Agents (ERPA). IRS CE is only mandatory for EAs and ERPAs.

CPAs

Enrolled Actuaries

ISCEBS is a qualified sponsor of continuing education programs for enrolled actuaries under Section 20 CFR Part 90(g)(2)(iii) of the final rules and regulations governing those enrolled to perform actuarial services under ERISA. It is the actuary's responsibility to identify "core" and "noncore" hours of credit. The \$25 service charge does not apply.

HRCI Credit for PHR®, SPHR® and GPHR® Recertification

HRCI awards 30 credit hours for each ISCEBS Fellow examination passed. Your pass notice from the Prometric Testing Center is your proof of satisfactory completion. HRCI recommends you retain all supporting documentation for at least six months after successful recertification. No further documentation is needed from ISCEBS. The \$25 service charge does not apply.

SHRM-CP, SHRM-SCP

The 2020 ISCEBS Fellow courses will be submitted to SHRM for 30 credit hours for each ISCEBS examination passed. A certificate with the activity ID number will be sent upon completion if requested on registration form.
