Dr. Cristina Banks is the Director of the Interdisciplinary Center for Healthy Workplaces at the University of California, Berkeley, where she leads an interdisciplinary team of scholars and practitioners in innovative research projects designed to create healthy workplaces. Dr. Banks is leading an ambitious project with an interdisciplinary team of experts to reimagine the future of work, worker experience, and workplaces—the Work Futures Initiative. Dr. Banks is also Associate Director of the California Labor Lab, a Total Worker Health Center of Excellence funded by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health. She is also a Senior Lecturer at the Haas School of Business at UC Berkeley where she serves as Faculty Director of a new initiative to promote workplace mental health. Dr. Banks is the Past President of the Society for Total Worker Health, and a Fellow for the Society for Industrial-Organizational Psychology and the American Psychological Association.
